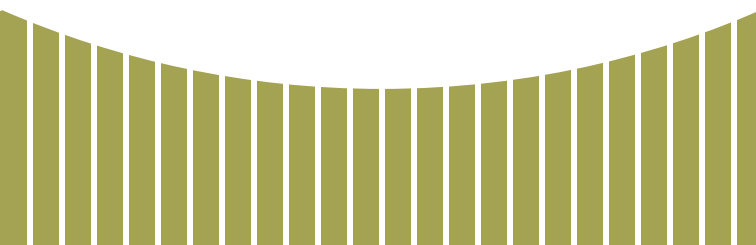

## PUEBLA

### *De los Angeles*

The city of Puebla de los Angeles, is located less than two hours from Mexico City. Puebla's magnificent historic buildings and its vibrant progressive spirit make this cosmopolitan city one of Mexico's top five urban centers.

Puebla is also famous for its traditional handcrafts; colorful Talavera ceramics, paintings on *amate* bark paper and richly embroidered cloth.

The city's historical center, declared a World Heritage Site by UNESCO in 1987, makes an ideal setting for the Camino Real Puebla, located only steps away from a multitude of tourist attractions; the Cathedral, the Chapel of the Rosary, the Palafox Library, the Amparo Museo, and the ancient *Callejón del Sapo*





(Toad Alley). The Convention Center is located only a few blocks from the hotel. Latin America's largest zoological reserve, where visitors can watch animals roaming freely in a natural habitat, is located not far from the city.

Today, housed in this splendid architectural jewel, the Camino Real offers all the amenities and services of a modern hotel.

Surrounded by lovely grounds, the Camino Real's 84 rooms and suites are decorated with original frescoes, furniture and art pieces from Mexico's Viceroyal period, which lasted from the seventeenth to the nineteenth century.
